
Most or all of funding used to pay for work at contract research organizations (CROs). *Not intended to support research within Yale labs*

Selection Criteria

- Research addresses major unmet need
- Strong indications of commercial interest
- Technology is near a "value inflection point"
- Technology is **patentable** with freedom to operate
- Engaged, committed principal investigator

A 5-minute slide pitch is all you need for your pre-proposal submission!

Just get together 6-8 PowerPoint slides that you can present in <u>5 minutes</u> that answer these basic questions:



Product

What's the product/service?



Market Landscape

What's the market? What's the competition?



Product Strategy

What are your differentiating unique benefits?
How would this product make money?



Current State

What is the status of your product?
Who is on your team?



Purpose

What would you accomplish with Blavatnik funding?
What do you aim to make happen with these results in hand? With whom?




